

Wild turkey - Hunting seasons

Wild turkey (bearded or not) (note 2) Firearms, crossbow and bow (note3)	4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10	October 24, 2020 to October 30, 2020 Hunting is permitted one-half hour before sunrise until noon.	October 23, 2021 to October 29, 2020 Hunting is permitted one-half hour before sunrise until noon.

Note 1: For the spring season the bag limit is of two bearded wild turkeys. However, the second turkey must be bagged in one of the following Zones: **4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10.**

➤ **Note 2:** For the fall season the bag limit is of one wild turkey, bearded or not. The use of a dog (pointer or flusher) is permitted.

Note 3: 10, 12, 16 or 20 gauge shotguns using #4, #5 or #6 cartridges and black powder firearms using #4, #5, or #6 shot are permitted. Crossbows and bows, as well as arrows permitting a cutting diameter of 22 mm (7/8") or more are also permitted.
